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Введение

Для учащихся начальной школы и среднего звена проще найти и использовать такие

эффективные приемы. Это могут быть рифмовки, стихотворения, игры, проведение нестандартных

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уроков. Одним из таких эффективных приемов для старшеклассников, считаю использование викторин. Это способствует дополнительной мотивации учащихся, стимулирует их лингвистическую активность, обеспечивая вместе с тем, развитие социокультурной компетенции и поддерживает их интерес к изучению иностранного языка в целом, оживляет атмосферу урока.

Целью проведения викторин в старших классах (10-11 классы) является формирование коммуникативной компетенции, т.е. способности и готовности осуществлять иноязычное, межличностное и межкультурное общение с носителями языка.
